CRISP & ZESTY

LA MANDA SAUVIGNON BLANC 2007, (CHILE) £13.75

Crisp, citrus-led Sauvignon blanc, with just the right juicy acidity.

RIVE HAUTE COLOMBARD SAUVIGNON BLANC 2007, (FRANCE) £14.85

Zesty, dry Southern French white with ripe citrus fruit character.

PINOT GRIGIO VIVALLIS TRENTINO 2007, (ITALY) £15.30

Here in the hills of Trentino you find the real refreshing but ripe flavoured grapes that make this a fantastic Pinot Grigio.

BRAMPTON SAUVIGNON BLANC STELLENBOSCH 2006/07, (SOUTH AFRICA) £18.95

A crisp and zesty upfront Sauvignon in true New World style. Fleshy and well rounded, clean and packed with gooseberry and passion fruit flavours.

TINDALL VINEYARD 2007, MARLBOROUGH (NZ) £23.25

Home of some of the greatest Sauvignon Blancs in the World. The cool climate and long hours of sunshine produce a wine with gooseberry fruit and herbaceous flavours.

SPARKLING

VALDOBBIADENE PROSECCO COL VETORAZ 2006, (ITALY) £23.00

This is a deep and fruity wine, lovely rounded rich peach and apricot flavours with a positively tingling lingering finish.

FRESH & FLORAL

BOTTLE TREE (UNOAKED) CHARDONNAY 2005, (SE AUSTRALIA) £16.85

An elegant and zesty Chardonnay with grapefruit and hints of gooseberry on the nose. Wonderful on the palate!

EXPLORER GEWURZTRAMINER 2007, (CHILE) £17.65

This wine is wonderfully fresh, with an exceptional fruity taste and well balanced acidity. This is a result of the perfect growing conditions of the Central Valley and of Concha Y Toro wine making.

CHATEAU LAMOTHE BLANC DE BLANCS, BORDEAUX, 2007 (FRANCE) £17.95

Classic white Bordeaux, a blend of Semillion and Sauvignon gives fresh citrus characters, And a small percentage of Muscadelle lends a gentle honey finish.

NAVAJAS RIOJA BODEGAS BLANCO CRIANZA 2004, (SPAIN) £21.95

Excellently made wine. Dry and crisp with notes of apple and melon with a nutty finish.

LA MESMA GAVI DI GAVI DOCG 2006/7, (ITALY) £23.15

Great family winery, they only make Gavi di Gavi from their own vines, proper specialists in this most archetypal of dry wines, clean crisp and refreshing.

MAGNUM

CHABLIS DOMAINE DE BOIS D'YVER, 2003, BURGUNDY (FRANCE) £47.00

A classic Chablis from Pico Race. Delightfully flinty, steely bone dry, fruity and rich. Enhanced with magnum ageing.

CHAMPAGNE

FORGET-BRIMONT 1er CRU BRUT £32.50 BY THE GLASS £6.95

Aged for 18-24 months before release, Michel Forget's Champagne shows elegant maturity with good fruit on the palate and a soft creamy mousse.

VEUVE CLICQUOT YELLOW LABEL £45.00

This dry Champagne is a blend of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay, balancing body & elegance. It shows persistent sparkle, golden colour, complex nose of apple, citrus and caramel and a slightly spicy finish.

BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE, AY £55.00

Made from 60% Pinot Noir, 25% Chardonnay & 15% Pinot Meunier it is matured over four years. The wine has a full bodied and fruity style, with a rich, elegant nose of yeast and biscuit.

ROSÉ WINES

LA MANDA ROSÉ 2007 (CHILE) £13.75 by the glass £3.45/£4.60

Deep in colour with fleshy plum aromas leading to a juicy, well structured palate. A full flavoured, well balanced Rosé.

CORBIERES, DOMAINE STE EUGENIE 2007, LANGUEDOC (FRANCE) £17.50

A superb Rosé with a delightful strawberry bouquet and a full refreshing palate of ripe, red fruits.

WHITES BY THE HALF BOTTLE

SAINT FLORIN BLANC 2005/06, BORDEAUX (FRANCE) £10.50

A new style of white Bordeaux showing great depth and flavour on the palate with bright aromatics on the nose, fresh and clean flavours linger in the finish.

MACON LUGNY, LOUIS LATOUR 2007, BURGUNDY (FRANCE) £13.95

One of the best communes of Burgundy's Mâconnais. The wine is clean and lively with a flowery bouquet and lovely honey, apples and nutty flavours on the palate.

CHABLIS EMILE PETIT 2006, BURGUNDY (FRANCE) £15.65

Crisp and fresh with aromas of apples combined with underlying minerality. Typical Chablis that makes an ideal accompaniment to seafood and fish dishes.

SANCERRE DOMAINE BROCHARD 2005, LOIRE (FRANCE) £15.85

Produced in the village of Chavignol, with overtones of gooseberries.

CLASSIC & ELEGANT

MACON VILLAGES JAFFELIN 2006, BURGUNDY (FRANCE) £23.85

A full, yet balanced Chardonnay, the ripe melon and fig fruit is complemented by nutty, spicy oak notes.

SANCERRE VINCENT PINARD CUVÉE FLORES 2005, (FRANCE) £27.95

Great old school Sancerre from a very, very well respected producer. Refreshing and clean.

CHABLIS PRIEURIE ST.COME 2006, BURGUNDY (FRANCE) £28.50

This great expression of the Chardonnay grape has that fully rounded but stylish buttery warm flavour. Here elegantly classic, poised rich and characterful.

ELENA WALSH PINOT GRIGIO 2005/06, (ITALY) £30.25

The ultimate in fine alpine Pinot Grigio. Produced by "Wine heroine" Elena Walsh. This organic and bio-dynamic masterpiece displays rich vibrant and nutty fruit characteristics. Perfect aristocratic Pinot.

POUILLY FUME SILICE BLANCHET 2006, LOIRE (FRANCE) £31.00

M. Blanchet has a small parcel of vines planted in Silex soil, giving a special 'flinty' quality. Bursting with aromatic fruit, balanced acidity and a special fruit 'kick'.

CREAMY & ROUNDED

BOURGOGNE BLANC CHARDONNAY, DOMAIN MALLARD 2007, (FRANCE) £26.15

A finely made Chardonnay - the lime and stone fruits balanced with restrained oak are the traits of this high class wine. This easily ranks alongside many wines from higher-designated appellations.

HOLLICK CHARDONNAY RESERVE 2005, COONAWARRA (AUSTRALIA) £27.75

A wonderful barrel-fermented Chardonnay full of citrus melon and peach flavours balanced by notes of toasted cashew nuts. This intense wine has perfect balance.

CHABLIS 1ER CRU VAULIGNEAU ALAIN GEOFFROY 2004, BURGUNDY (FRANCE) £32.75

Pure Chardonnay grapes with no oak contact, provides concentrated stone fruit flavours, citrus notes and an underlying minerality that lingers long in the mouth.

MEURSAULT GRAND CHARRONS 'MASON CHAMPY' 2004, BURGUNDY (FRANCE) £42.50

Dimitri Bazas an incredibly talented young wine maker turns back the hands of time with this classic retro Meursault. Creamy exotic vanilla, rich and buttery with a perfect finish of toasted brioche.

PULIGNY MONTRACHET DOMAINE CHATRON & TREBUCHET 2006, BURGUNDY (FRANCE) £49.75

Typical lean mineral elegance with a nose featuring an oatmeal edge and subtle smoky nuances. Perfectly balanced finish with layers of apricots and almonds.

PRESTIGE CHAMPAGNE

BOLLINGER GRANDE ANNÉE 1999, AY £85.00

Aged for five years on the lees, created using a blend of 65% Pinot Noir and 35% Chardonnay. Dry, full bodied and rich, encapsulating meaty flavours with subtle aromas of sultanas and nuts.

DOM PERIGNON 1999/2000 £110.00

Dom Perignon has become a symbol of all things good. It has overtones of fresh baked Brioche and white peaches with subtle spicy aromas, vanilla and praline on the nose.

ROSÉ CHAMPAGNE

FORGET-BRIMONT ROSÉ £37.50 BY THE GLASS £7.35

This excellent Rosé Champagne has won numerous awards for its quality. It also makes for a refreshing summertime aperitif.

BILLECART-SALMON ROSÉ £65.00

Pale, even, onion skin/pink colour and a fairly fine, persistent mousse. Toasty and creamy nose with aromas of straw and strawberries. Bone dry with rich, toasty flavours, redcurrant & strawberry fruit leading nicely to a long, fresh, finish.

CA'LUNGHETTA PINOT GRIGIO ROSÉ 2007, (ITALY) £18.85

Top quality crisp dry nose, a little Pinot Noir in the blend giving a delicate colour and hints of berry fruit.

CIELO DE'OR SPARKLING PINOT GRIGIO ROSÉ (ITALY) £21.95

Ripe red fruit character with a hint of sweetness on the finish.

SANGIOVESE COLLE DEL GELSO 2006, (ITALY) £3.45/ £4.60

CABERNET MERLOT STE EUGENIE 2004, (FRANCE) £3.95/ £5.45

SHIRAZ GRANT BURGE 'BENCHMARK' 2005, (SOUTH AUSTRALIA) £4.15/ £5.60

RIOJA TINTO BODEGAS SIERRA CANTABRIA 2006, (SPAIN) £4.30/ £5.85

REDS BY THE BOTTLE

SOFT AND FRUITFUL

SANGIOVESE COLLE DEL GELSO EMILIA ROMAGNA 2006 (ITALY) £13.75
Fruity, vibrant and appealing red wine from the Emilia region's local grape.

LA MANDA CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2007, (CHILE) £14.75
Ripe cassis fruit with mellow undercurrents of mint & herbs, and a soft rounded finish.

STE EUGENIE CABERNET MERLOT 2004, (FRANCE) £15.65
Classic combination 'blackcurrant' Cabernet and spicy aromatic Merlot, ripened under Southern French Mediterranean sunshine, soft gentle & comforting, 'elegantly rustic'.

FILIUS DE CHATEAU LAMOTHE 2006, BORDEAUX (FRANCE) £16.60
An elegantly made Claret, with a core of cassis and plum fruit, balanced by herb notes and soft tannins.

RIOJA TINTO BODEGAS SIERRA CANTABRIA 2006, RIOJA (SPAIN) £17.10
The aroma has raspberries and blackberries with hints of coffee, toast and vanilla. Well structured with balanced tannins, fresh mature fruit in perfect harmony.

CHATEAU HAUT GIRAUDON 2005 ST EMILION, BORDEAUX(FRANCE) £24.50
This is a true example of St Emilion offering a sweet floral nose, oodles of ripe chewy fruit on the palate and a rich meaty finish that lingers for an age. Truly delightful!

HOLLICK CABERNET/ MERLOT 2004, COONAWARRA (AUSTRALIA) £28.15
Ripe upfront fruit on the nose, with the blackcurrant and menthol notes of the Cabernet Sauvignon being foremost and soft plummy fruit of the Merlot behind.

BIG, SPICY & JAM PACKED

GRANT BURGE 'BENCHMARK' SHIRAZ 2005, (SOUTH AUSTRALIA) £16.50
Deep red colour with an aroma distinguished by typical rich Shiraz fruit characters and rich vanilla oak. The palate is full and flavoursome.

MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO MIGLIANICO MONTUPOLI 2005, (ITALY) £16.75
Fantastic producers on the Arbruzzi coast. Ripe, firm, gripping and full of intense flavours of hillside fruit.

CARMEN MERLOT 2006, (CHILE) £17.75
One of the oldest Chilean wineries. An enticing bouquet of berries and plums and a velvety texture, soft yet firm with intriguing flavours of cherry and chocolate.

MALBEC RINCON PRIVADO 2006, (ARGENTINA) £18.40
A superlative example of this grape. Perfumed aromas and a velvety full-bodied palate of ripe berries and spices.

MARTUE, TIERRA DI CASTILLA 2004, (SPAIN) £22.95
Rich, warming, smoky fruit flavours with a hint of vanilla and nutmeg & cinnamon spices. Long gentle finish.

CÔTES DU RHÔNE GUIGAL 2004, (FRANCE) £26.75
This red wine with blackcurrant, blueberry and blackberry aromas is round in the mouth with light liquorice notes at the finish.

MAGNUM

CHATEAU LAMOTHE DE HAUX 1 ER COTES DE BORDEAUX, 2005, (FRANCE) £40
An elegantly made magnum aged Claret, with a core of cassis and plum fruit, balanced by herb notes and soft tannins.

DESSERT WINE

CHATEAU MANOS, CADILLAC 2005, BORDEAUX (FRANCE)
375ml £19.25 By the glass 75ml £3.95
Superb, with a rich concentration of fruit flavours, complex, sweet and luscious.

THE NECTAR IAN HOLLICK 2004, COONAWARRA (AUSTRALIA)
375ml £27.50 By the glass 75ml £4.35
The wines are rich and sweet, dried apricot and honey overtones from the Botrytis infection, balanced with concentrated fruit characters and a clean acid finish.

REDS BY THE HALF BOTTLE

BEAUJOLAIS VILLAGES 2006 (FRANCE) £9.75
Classic light Gamay fruit, raspberries, cherries and delightful 'bubblegum flavours'. Room temperature or lightly chilled.

RIOJA SIERRA CANTABRIA CRIANZA 2004, (SPAIN) £14.75
Raspberries and blackberries of nice intensity with hints of coffee, toast and vanilla. It is well structured with balanced tannins, fresh mature fruit in perfect harmony.

CHATEAU LAMOTHE DE HAUX 1er COTES DE BORDEAUX 2005, BORDEAUX (FRANCE) £12.95
An elegantly made Claret, with a core of cassis and plum fruit, balanced by herb notes and soft tannins.

GENTLE & ELEGANT

CHIANTI DOCG TENUTA GIUSTINIANI 2005, (ITALY) £16.95
From the forgotten region of Chianti, the hills around Pisa. Lovely cherry fruits and cedar scents at a fraction of the cost of their more southerly neighbours.

TEMPRANILLO CIGALES TINTO ROBLE 2005 (SPAIN) £21.15
100% Tempranillo from a region to the west of Rioja. Thick full fruit flavours from old vineyards, the producer reckons its perfect with the boar he hunts, big hearted but with a smooth touch of vanilla oak. An unfamiliar name but a real cracker!

TRENTHAM PINOT NOIR 2005, MURRAY RIVER (AUSTRALIA) £22.95
Another little gem from Tony Murphy. A complex and ripe Pinot style with notes of liquorice on the palate that add further complexity.

HAUTES COTES DE BEAUNE PINOT NOIR DOMAINE PRIEURE 2006, BURGUNDY (FRANCE) £23.50
Soft, excellently weighted Pinot Noir with cherry and raspberry fruit, underpinned by hints of spice and oak.

BROUILLY, CHATEAU BEILLARD, 2007 (FRANCE) £26.50
With a little more body and complexity than Beaujolais Villages, the wines of Brouilly have floral scents and ripe cherry fruit, with oak and spice on the finish.

CROZES HERMITAGE DOMAINE DES ENTREFAUX 2005, RHÔNE (FRANCE) £28.30
From the heart of the Crozes appellation. This wine is loaded with raspberry and liquorice flavours that offer a powerful palate and a rich chocolate flavour finish.

MERCUREY ROUGE EMILE JUILLOT 2003, BURGUNDY (FRANCE) £29.50
The Juillots are an old Burgundian family making this bright, ripe, open Pinot Noir with red fruit flavours and hints of liquorice on the palate.

CLASSIC & FULL BODIED

COMMISSIONER'S BLOCK SHIRAZ/VIIGNIER 2006, (AUSTRALIA) £18.50
Full bodied showing plenty of ripe jammy blackberry fruit, hints of spice and a trace of perfume from the addition of a tiny percentage of Viognier to the blend. A big wine for the price!

JEWEL OLD VINE ZINFANDEL 2004, (USA) £22.35.
This wine has stunning complexity resulting from using 40-50 year old vines; berries, black cherries and spices with well-integrated tannins.

RUSTENBERG JOHN X MERRIMAN 2004, STELLENBOSCH (SOUTH AFRICA) £28.95
Almost New World St Emilion with its high proportion of Merlot in the blend. Aromas of spice and red fruit, matched on the palate with fine, elegant tannins.

AMARONE, RIGHETTI 2004, (ITALY) £32.50
This classic Amarone is slightly sweet, warming and robust with great balance and a velvety finish with the most satisfying touch of bitter chocolate.

COPPOLA SILVER LABEL PINOT NOIR 2006, (USA) £33.25
Deep garnet in colour, enticing aroma of strawberries on the nose and hints of cherry and dried cranberry on the palate. 'The Godfather' of Pinot Noir!

CHATEAU LA CROIX DU CASSE 2000 POMEROL, BORDEAUX (FRANCE) £57.25
One of the greatest wine making areas of Bordeaux. This very impressive offering shows rich blackberry fruit, balanced by hints of smoky new oak.

CHAMBOLLE MUSIGNY 1er CRU J. DROUHIN 2004, BURGUNDY (FRANCE) £70.15
From the Cote de Nuits, now drinking exceptionally well. Full bodied, complex, beautifully balanced with silky smooth tannins. Good colour and lovely aromas.

MAURY "MAS AMIEL" 2005, RHÔNE (FRANCE)
750ml £32.95 By the glass 75ml £3.50
This rich, dark and fruity red has high residual sugar and soft ripe tannins that balance perfectly with chocolate and red fruit desserts. Made as a Vin doux Naturel.

TOKAJI ASZU 5 PUTTONYOS CHATEAU DEREZLA 2003, (HUNGARY)
500ml £33.75 By the glass 75ml £5.65
Picked berry by berry to ensure only the finest affected grapes are used. Full flavoured and luscious, hints of orange peel above the intense fresh fruit aromas.

VINTAGES MAY VARY
